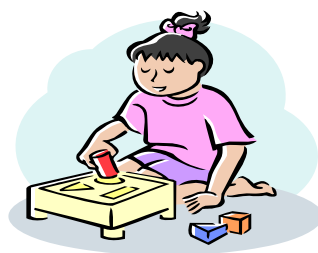

Please dress comfortably so that you can move freely, with your knees and elbows covered, and bring any medication that you may need with you (especially those with diabetes or asthma).

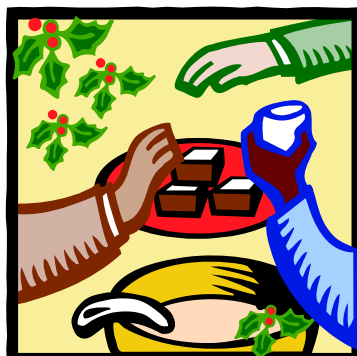
Places are limited and will be on a first come first served basis, and as parking is limited we are hoping to car sharing so can you let us know if you are able to take others in your car.
